**Important Note #1:** We will exit the track at Turn 7 after checkered flag as we have in the past. This allows us to open the paddock crossing and minimize down time. If you don't know where T7 is located and how to get off the track, please find out!!! There is a map included here. If you miss the exit and are given **the red flag** at Turn 8, you may **not be allowed to drive in your next session.**

**Important Note #2:** No Friday night drags are scheduled for this weekend.

**Important Note #3: Friday Entry to Facility**

NASA participants may arrive anytime to participate in test and tune, drop off their cars, equipment and setup for the weekend.

**Important Note #4:** **The Saturday Evening Party is at the Pueblo VFW.** We will be doing awards from the 2016 season.

**Important Note #5:** Tech will be ready at 1PM on Friday for those that haven't gotten their annual yet. At track inspection fee is \$50 for race annuals, \$20 for TT and HPDE.

## All Drivers

- The speed limit within the paddock is **5 mph**. Pit lane speed limit is **25mph**.
- Children under 14 and pets must be supervised at all times.
- Do not leave any hazardous materials (used fluids, tires, batteries, etc) at the facility.
- In the interest of safety, **only licensed drivers may operate wheeled vehicles anywhere within the facility**. This includes bikes, scooters, ATV, skateboards, etc. Any vehicles being used in conflict with this policy will be **confiscated by NASA** for the remainder of the weekend.
- If you are parked on an asphalt surface, place boards under jacks, trailer legs and canopies to prevent damage. If you spill fluids get them cleaned up quickly (water on gas spills, kitty litter on oil/etc) and report the spill to a NASA official if you need help. Any damage done to the paddock facility by a participant will be the responsibility of that participant.

### **Food and Concessions**

Smokin Sage will be on site serving up their normal BBQ goodness both days.

### **Overnight Camping**

Overnight camping is permitted at no cost. There is a shower available - Check with Driver Info. There are a few electrical hookups, however do not plug into them without asking Pueblo Staff.

### **Hotels**

There are many hotels within minutes of the track and some may offer discounts if you tell them you are racing with NASA at Pueblo.

### **Tire Service**

OnSite Tires will be doing tire service for us. So if you need tires brought for you, give them a call. 720-410-7007

### **Fuel**

Regular pump gas can be found just minutes away from the track. If you need race gas (i.e. >91 octane) it is still BYOB at this time.

### **Directions to Pueblo Motorsports Park**

3733 N Pueblo Blvd  
Pueblo, CO 81008

From I-25, go west on Hwy 50 (exit 101) 2.6 miles to Pueblo Blvd. Turn Left on Pueblo Blvd and go 0.3 miles. The entrance is the first right off of Pueblo Blvd. Follow the paved entrance until you reach the road course paddock.
