TT Tech Forms

If you do not have a 2017 annual sticker, bring the signed tech form http://www.nasaproring.com/images/rules-forms/form_hpde_tech.pdf to grid for your first session and place it under your windshield wiper. An official will collect the form and place a group sticker on your windshield. **You will not be allowed on track without the completed, signed form and your TT wristband!**

At track Annual Inspection

Please note that Saturday/Sunday “at track” TT Annual Inspections will cost \$20. If you do not live within 60 miles of an approved tech shop contact NASA RM prior to the event for an exception to this rule.

There is a mandatory TT driver’s meeting on Saturday AM. Make sure that you give yourself enough time to unload (tires, tech, etc) and attend the meeting on time. **DO NOT BE LATE OR YOU MAY MISS TRACK TIME!!!!**

TT Class Designators & NASA Stickers

Please insure that your car has the minimum for class designators on your car. This is each side and the rear. Since TT is a competitive series, you are required to display NASA stickers.

Friday Test and Tune

The track is hosting the test and tune on the Friday before our event. **Vehicles crashed or broken during the test and tune day WILL NOT be eligible for refund of NASA entry fees. You may transfer to a future event.**
